Initial focus is on information gathering and consequence analysis.</p> <p>During Emergency Events, staff may not be able to produce a full IAP for the next Operational Period. As such, the above objectives will continue to each Operational Period until a regular schedule of meetings and reviews can be obtained. As soon as possible, the Incident Cycle and Meeting Schedule must be initiated to begin Development of subsequent Operational Period's Incident Action Plan.</p>
