Participants will come for one hour and leave with the tools needed to prepare themselves and their families in the event of a hurricane.

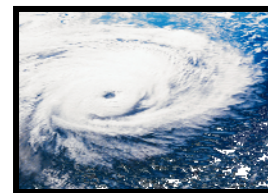
